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**Outlined below are some of the key areas which are going to be covered in your child's class this term.**

<u>SUBJECT</u>	<u>SOME KEY AREAS</u>
R.E.	We will be studying the following units in RE alongside our work on CAFOD and Harvest: Christmas/Epiphany Baptism Being part of a family Lent/Easter
Literacy	<b>In English this term will be learning to:</b> Pattern and rhymes. Exploring stories with repeating patterns. Information texts. <b>When writing we will be learning to:</b> Hold a pencil correctly. Form upper and lower case letters correctly. Leave spaces between words. Punctuate sentences correctly using: capital letters, a full stop, exclamation mark and questions mark. Say a sentence out loud before we write it. Use the conjunction 'and' to join two sentences together. newspaper reports.
Numeracy	<b>In Maths we will focus on numbers and place value.</b> One more and one less Locating numbers on a 100 number square Understanding tens and ones in 2digit numbers Doubles up to 5, 6, 7, and 10 Adding and subtracting 3d shape Counting in multiples of 2 and 5 Looking at odd and even numbers Days of the week, months of the year and time
SCIENCE	Identifying animals Seasonal changes
HUMANITIES	Toys in the past. Let's go on safari!
MUSIC and Art/DT	Through a cross curricular approach.

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<b>P.E.</b>	PE will be gymnastics and team games. This involves developing accurate skills of throwing, rolling, kicking and striking balls, using beanbags to throw and catch and playing a variety of games following instructions and developing good team spirit. Gymnastics involves developing the skills of balance, floor work and travelling in a variety of ways with good control.
<b>Computing</b>	Children will become more familiar using a keyboard to type sentences. They will develop confidence using a mouse to select icons. They will use purple mash and 'spellodrome' to help them learn.
