Year One autumn curriculum overview.

English.	<p><u>In English this term we will be learning to:</u> Write captions, labels and write lists; Write instructions and explore stories through the following units of work: - Fiction Unit 1.1 Guess what? Poetry Unit 1.1 Sensational Senses Non-fiction Unit 1.1 Who lives here? Live Unit 1.1 Poetry Star!</p> <p><u>When writing we will be learning to:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a pencil correctly. • Form upper and lower case letters correctly. • Leave spaces between words. • Punctuate sentences correctly using: capital letters, a full stop, exclamation mark and questions mark. • Say a sentence out loud before we write it.
Maths.	<p><u>Number and place value</u> -counting forwards and backwards to 100, read and write numbers to 100, count objects and estimate, recognise numbers, coins, dominos and dice.</p> <p><u>Mental addition and subtraction</u> - using a number line to add and subtract, using objects to add and subtract, number bonds to 10, one more/ one less than a number, problem solving skills.</p> <p><u>Geometry: properties of shapes</u> - to recognise 2D shapes and sort shapes according to their properties, using Venn diagrams and Carroll diagrams. <u>Geometry: position and direct</u> - Describe position and direction using common words (including half turns); compare lengths and heights; estimate, compare and measure lengths using uniform non-standard and standard units.</p> <p><u>Mental multiplication and division</u> - doubles, problem solving skills.</p>
Science	<p><u>My body</u> - name and label our body parts, understand how we move and explore our five senses.</p> <p><u>Everyday Materials</u> - properties of materials, making observations and exploring materials, name and describe different materials.</p>
RE	<p>We will be studying the following units in RE alongside our work on CAFOD and Harvest: Creation</p>
