


In Reception this week we are learning:

Book of the week:



Religion

In Religion we will be looking at Baptismal candles to remind us that Jesus is our light. We will write prayers about those people who care for us.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development



We will join others in EYFS taking part in a Teddy bears picnic.

We shall also think about the actions of Goldilocks. Was she right or wrong?

Communication & Language/Literacy



We will retell the story of Goldilocks and the three bears. We shall also follow instructions to make porridge describing how it tastes, then write our own instructions.

Phonics sounds this week are: oa, long oo & short oo sounds.

Physical Development



We will use scissors to make our own Goldilocks. In PE this week we will travelling in different ways.

Understanding of the World



We will play games on the computer ordering objects according to size.

When making porridge we will think about how it changes.

We shall also talk about those people who we care about and special times spent with them.

Mathematics



In Mathematics we will be comparing lengths and heights of objects. We will also compare the weights of pairs of items. We will also order numbers.

Expressive Arts and Design



We will create hearts from different materials to celebrate Valentines day. We will build a chair for Baby bear using different construction materials.

How you can help:

This week we have explored both 2D and 3D shapes.

Collect some objects you have in the house that are 3D shapes

e.g. cereal boxes, crisp tubes, oranges, boxes. Sort them into groups of the same shapes. How many objects do you have corners? How many round objects do you have? How many have curved edges or sides?

Tell someone the story of Goldilocks and the three Bears then write some sentences to tell the story and draw a picture.
