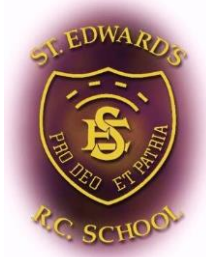


Overview:

English.

Maths.

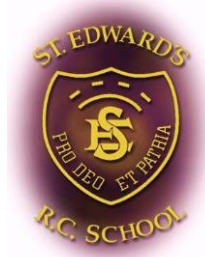
