Personal, Social & Emotional Development



This week in circle time, the children will be talking about how they and others show feelings, talking about their own and others' behaviour and thinking about the consequences of their actions.

We will be reading simple sentences and phrases.

Mathematics



In Maths, we will be:

- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Adding two single digit numbers e.g. $5+4 =$
- Taking away using single digits e.g. $7-3 =$
- Recording our answers using number sentences.

Physical Development



In PE this week, the children will become running athletes. They will learn all about sprinting and long distance running. We will also be playing chasing games.

In class will continue to focus on correct letter and number formation.

Understanding the world



We will be going in search of bog babies through our wooded area.

We will be learning to use a class microscope to look closely at mini beasts.

Expressive art and design



The children will be creating their own habitats for their bog babies to live in.
