Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

English

Writing opportunities include myths and legends and persuasive writing.

SPaG focuses include using simple past and present perfect form of tenses and using the first 2 or 3 letters of a word to check its spelling in a dictionary.

Maths

Fractions: What is a fraction? Equivalent fractions, Fractions greater than 1, Count in Fractions, Add and subtract 2 or more fractions, Calculate fractions of a quantity, Problem solving – calculate quantities.

Decimals: Recognise tenths and hundredths, Tenths as decimals
Tenths on a place value grid and on a number line, Hundredths as decimals, Hundredths on a place value grid, divide by 10 and 100.

Science

States of Matter: the differences between solids, liquids and gases, classifying objects and identifying their properties.

ICT

Logo: children will use coding language to control an on-screen turtle to create mathematical patterns.
