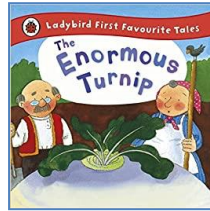

## Religion

In Religion we will explore the church and the church's family. During Collective Worship we look at a generous kind of love from God.



## Personal, Social & Emotional Development



We will continue to learn new rules, routines and expectations in reception. We will continue to talk about ourselves sharing our special items during show and tell. We shall play games and think about turn taking.

## Communication & Language/Literacy



We will practice writing our own name and other letters. We listen and retell the story 'The Enormous Turnip'. We will listen to each other and ask questions to learn more during show and tell. In Phonics we will explore instrumental sounds and the phonemes d and g.

## Physical Development



We will change into our PE kits and reach and stretch to retrieve and place objects as well as move equipment from one place to another. We will continue to practice letter patterns during handwriting.

## Understanding of the World



We will use the computer and practice mouse control by playing games. We will also look outside at nature observing how the seasons change around us.

## Mathematics



In Mathematics we will be counting and comparing amounts, recognising which group has more or less. We will match amounts to numerals and shall also explore the numbers 9 and 10.

## Expressive Arts and Design



We will use different foods to create faces in the style of the artist Acrimboldo. We will also use collage techniques to create churches and stained glass windows.
