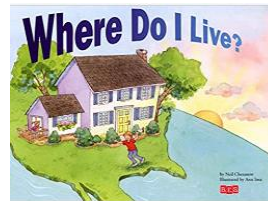


## Our theme is Where I live



## Story of the Week

Where do I live?



### COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE/LITERACY

Uses talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next, recall and relive past experiences.

Beginning to understand 'why' and 'how' questions.

### UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Shows interest in the lives of people who are familiar to them.

Shows interest in different occupations and ways of life. Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.

Completes a simple program on a computer.

### PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Confident to talk to other children when playing, and will communicate freely about own home and community.

### MATHEMATICS

Shows awareness of similarities of shape in the environment.

Uses shape appropriately for task.

Uses positional language

### RELIGION

Relationships they have in the family, at nursery/school, in the parish, neighbourhood and world.

Ways in which a Christian family and parish share and celebrate life, and show care for one another.

### EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Uses various construction materials.

Beginning to be interested in and describe the texture of things.

### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Travels with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment.

## How you can help:

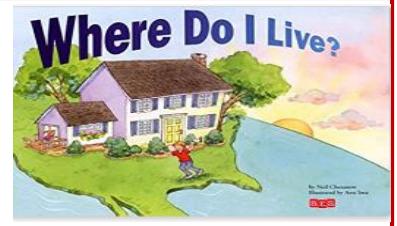
Over the next two weeks we will be looking at where we live. Talk to your child about where they live. What street do they live on? What suburb or town do they live in?
