Class Teacher will set daily Home Learning Activities via Purple Mash '2do tasks' focusing on **Maths, Reading and Writing**. **Topic** activities will be set twice weekly. All children will receive daily 2Dos notifications on Purple Mash accounts.

Class Teacher to provide communication and feedback to all children on **Maths, Reading and Writing** via Purple Mash. Feedback will focus on progress within tasks and based on outcomes.

If my child is SEND how will their provision differ so they can access learning?

The Class Teacher will work with the school SENDco to ensure work is differentiated and the child is able to access tasks.
