Learning Outcomes

- To understand that people are alike and contribute to the life of the community.
- To be able to discuss some of the special things that the priest does.
- That a Church building is a holy gathering place where everyone is welcome and where the community share and celebrate life, and worship together.
- To know that people love and care for each other in different ways.
- To know that Jesus gives an example of love and respect for others.
- To know that choices effect ourselves and others.

Unit overview

In this unit you will be introduced to the role of the priest as a special person in God's Family who helps people. This unit also has a focus on the church building as an important place within the parish community. You will also learn about a saint being an important person in God's Family and consider the help that Jesus gave to people when they needed it.
